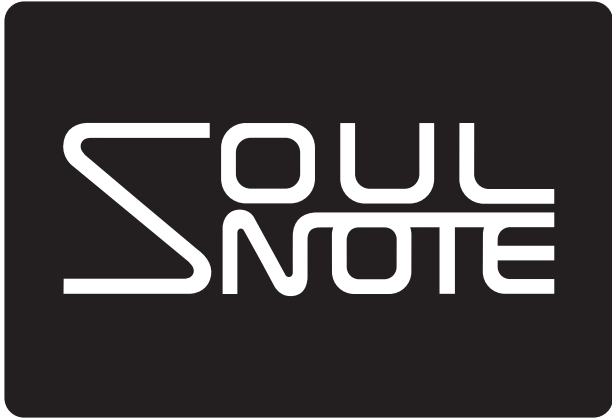

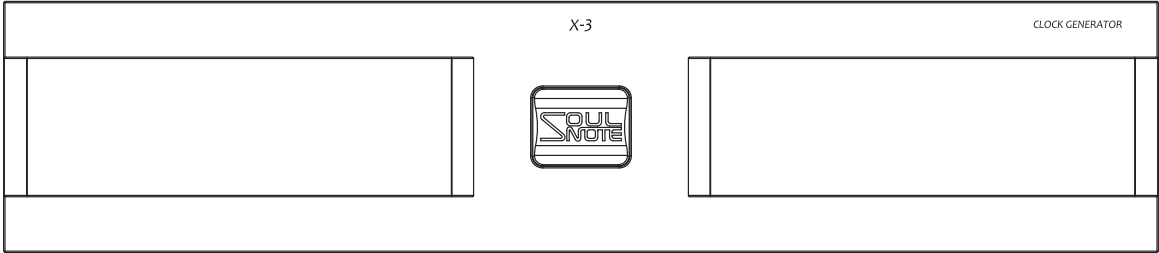

5. Do not use this apparatus near water.
6. Clean only with dry cloth.
7. Do not block any ventilation openings.
Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
8. Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
9. Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the apparatus.
10. Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.

WARNINGS

- Unplug the power cord when not using the unit for long periods of time.
- Do not obstruct the ventilation holes.
- Do not let foreign objects into the unit.
- Do not let insecticides, benzene, and thinner come in contact with the unit.
- Never disassemble or modify the unit in any way.
- Ventilation should not be impeded by covering the ventilation openings with items, such as newspapers, tablecloths or curtains.

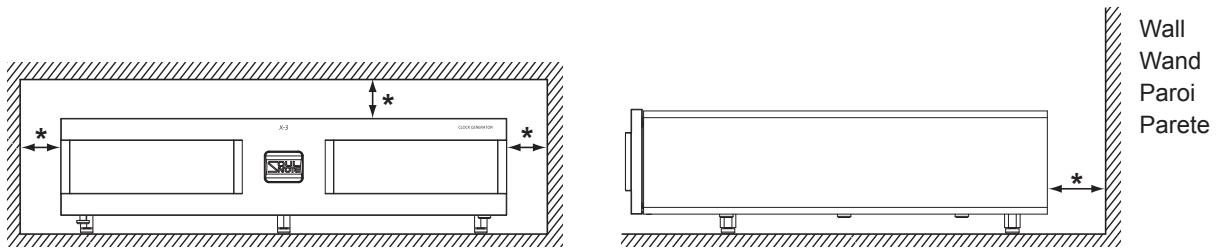
A NOTE ABOUT RECYCLING:

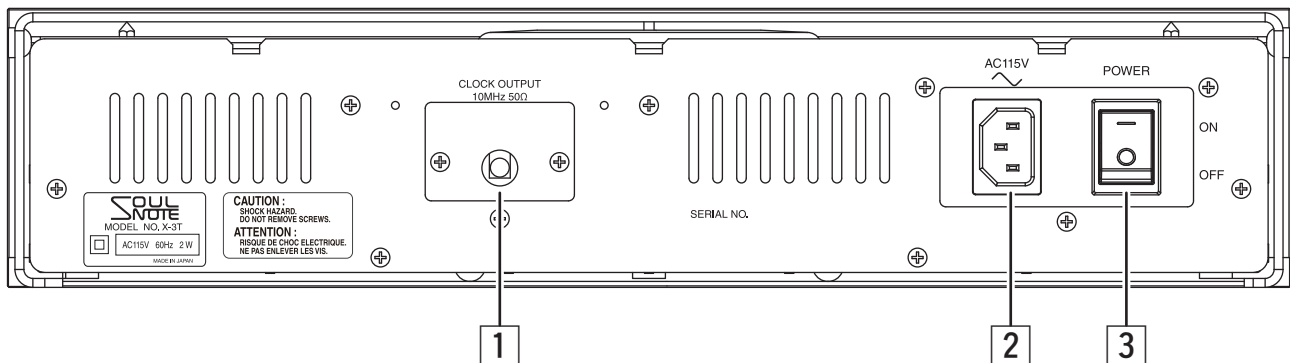
CAUTIONS ON INSTALLATION



*** For proper heat dispersal, do not install this unit in a confined space, such as a bookcase or similar enclosure.**

- Leave sufficient clearance (at least 10 cm) from the wall, (at least 5 cm) from top surface of the unit.
- Do not place any other equipment on this unit.

Rear Panel Names and Functions



1 10 MHz Clock Output Terminal (CLOCK OUTPUT)

Use a clock cable to connect to an external 10 MHz clock terminal such as D-3, S-3, or D-2.

Since this is an SMA terminal, when using a general BNC cable, be sure to use a BNC female – SMA male conversion adapter.

Precautions on connecting a clock cable

- When connecting a clock cable to a device, be sure to turn off the power of the device first.
- The clock output terminal is intentionally not secured in order to maintain the audio quality.
- When connecting an SMA cable, plug the cable straight into the terminal. Otherwise, the screw cannot be turned easily.
- First, turn the screw with your fingers as far as it will go.
- Then, use the supplied wrench to lightly tighten the screw to the point where it cannot be turned easily.
- **Do not overtighten the screw.**

- To fully enjoy the performance of the unit, it is recommended that you use an RCC-1 cable (sold separately) instead of the supplied SMA clock cable.

2 AC Inlet (115 V AC)

Connect to a 115 V AC wall outlet (mains) with the supplied power cable.

Notes:

- **Do not use any electrical contact cleaner or the like in the AC inlet area.**
- To maintain the audio quality, use the supplied power cable.
- Connect the power cable to the AC wall outlet (mains) by inserting the power plug prong with the engraved OO symbols into the ground side (the longer hole). If you reverse the orientation of the power plug, you cannot fully enjoy the performance of the unit.
- Firmly insert the power cable into the end of the AC inlet.
- The ground terminal and the housing are not connected.
- The AC inlet is intentionally not secured in order to maintain the audio quality.

3 Power Switch

Press the “-” side to turn on the power and press the “o” side to turn off the power.

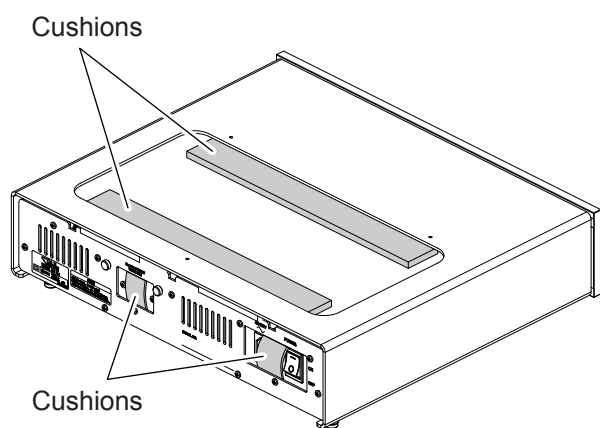
Notes:

- In order to maintain the audio quality, the unit is not equipped with functions other than the clock output, such as power status indications. The power on/off status can be confirmed with pressed state of the switch.
- In order to maintain the audio quality, it is good to keep the power on all the time.
- The power switch is intentionally not secured in order to maintain the audio quality.

Protection Pads for Transport

Before use, be sure to remove the pads from the unit. With the pads left attached, you cannot fully enjoy the high audio quality of the unit.

- In order to maintain the audio quality, the top cover and terminals on the rear panel are intentionally not secured.
- If you shake the unit, you will hear a rattling sound. It is not an abnormality.
- When you transport the unit, reattach the pads to the original places.

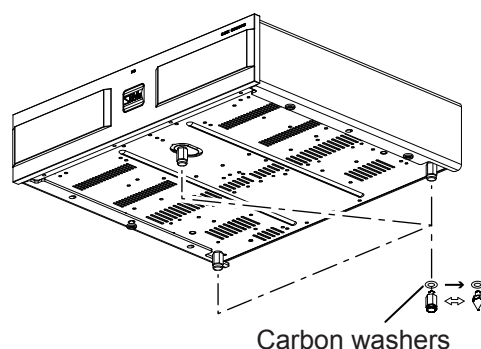


Attaching the Spike Pins

By replacing the feet with the supplied spike pins, you can tune the audio quality. Point grounding makes the sound focus and auditory lateralization sharper. Furthermore, the audio quality can be subtly tuned by changing the material of the surface on which this equipment is installed.

Notes:

- When replacing the feet with the spike pins, remove the carbon washers from the feet, and then reattach them to the spike pins.
- When the spike pins are attached, it may be difficult to keep weight balance stable. Take great care not to carelessly apply a force on the corners of the main unit.



Cautions

- When using the spike pins, be extremely careful not to get injured, etc.
- When using the spike pins, be careful that the surface on which the main unit is installed such as the surface of a table, shelf, etc., may become damaged.

Features of X-3

Feature 1: SC-cut Ultra-low Phase noise OCXO

Adopted an SC-cut ultra-low phase noise OCXO (Oven Controlled Crystal Oscillator) which achieves high audio quality.

Feature 2: Naked Foil Resistor

For the output resistor that greatly influences the audio quality of the clock, a satellite-grade ultraprecision resistor with a superior temperature characteristic and low heat noise was further customized specially for the unit. This extraordinary naked foil resistor is one of the important factors of the great audio quality.

Feature 3: SMA Output Terminal

Adopted an SMA terminal of 20 GHz or more for the output terminal. Focusing on achieving higher audio quality, only one output terminal is provided. To enjoy the dynamic sound of the music, it is highly recommended that you use an RCC-1 cable (sold separately) instead of the SMA-SMA 50 ohm clock cable supplied with X-3.

Feature 4: High-power Non-feedback Power Supply

For the power supply required for the crystal oscillator, a 200 VA toroidal transformer that has the largest capacity among 100 W amplifiers is adopted. For the rectifier diode, ultra-fast SiC diode is adopted for the first time. A multitude of electrolytic capacitors with low magnification and low capacity are connected in parallel to make up a group of rectifier capacitors. For regulators, SOULNOTE unique non-feedback power is supplied.

Feature 5: Quiet Power Supply Environment

The unit is not equipped with any functions that are unnecessary for the crystal oscillator such as power LED or relays. This enables the unit to provide a quiet power supply environment.

Feature 6: Housing Designed with Highest Priority Placed on Audio Quality

We newly developed a housing specially for X-3. The top cover with the top-bottom sides unsecured can prevent air-dumping. In addition, an unsecured AC inlet, an unsecured output terminal, 3 spike supports located just under the transformer, titanium washers, and carbon washers are adopted. These parts and ideas were adopted as a result of placing the highest priority on audio quality.

Troubleshooting

No sound is output. (The unit does not start.)

- Check that the power of the main unit is on.
- Check the connections of the external devices.
- Check that the power of the external devices is on.
- Check that the operations and settings on the external devices are correct.
- Check that the screw of the SMA cable is tightened all the way.

Maintenance

When the unit has become dirty, wipe it clean using a soft cloth. To remove stubborn stains, dilute some dish-washing liquid in 5 or 6 times as much water, soak a soft cloth in the solution, wring it out well, wipe away the stains, and then wipe the surfaces dry with a dry cloth.

Never use alcohol, paint thinners, benzine, insecticides or other volatile substances since they may mar or remove the surface gloss.

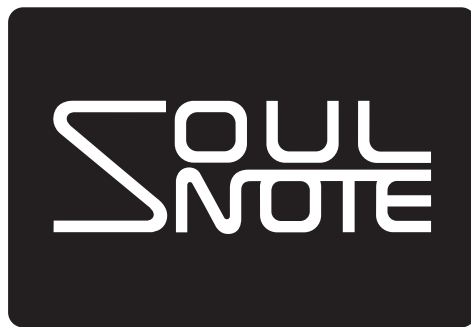
Bear in mind that rubbing surfaces with a chemical cleaning cloth or leaving such a cloth in contact with a surface for an extended time may result in deterioration.

- Do not use any electrical contact cleaner or the like in the AC inlet area. It will cause a faulty.
